# VA Disability Compensation

- Veterans receive monthly compensation pay from the VA for service-connected disabilities starting at 10%
- VA disability compensation is **NOT** a percentage of military retired pay.
  - The pay is a set rate paid by the combined disability ratingwith or without dependents (at 30%).
  - For example a 50% disabled Veteran with a spouse is paid \$917.13 each month.
- Prior to June 1, 2003 there was an offset to military retirement by VA disability dollar for dollar regardless of the percentage of VA disability or circumstances of disability.
- Veteran/retirees have the option not receive VA disability.

# **Concurrent Retirement & Disability Payment (CRDP)**

- CRDP became effective on January 1, 2004 as a 10-year phase-out program to eliminate the VA disability offset (waiver) from military retired pay.
- January 1, 2005 100% disabled individuals exempt from the 10-year phase-out and offset was completely eliminated.
- October 1, 2008 Those receiving Individual Unemployability are exempt from 10-year phase-out. Is retroactive to January 1, 2005.

### Concurrent Retirement & Disability Payment (CRDP) History

Initial Rates: CRDP is part of retired pay and cannot exceed the amount that would be otherwise offset. During CY 2004, CRDP was paid to qualified retirees up to the following maximum amount based on the current monthly VA disability rating:

VA Disability Rating	Initial CRDP Payment in CY 2004
100% (total)	\$750
90%	\$500
80%	\$350
70%	\$250
60%	\$125
50%	\$100

Phase Out: The above payments are increased each year following 2004, by additionally paying a percentage of the remaining amount of retired pay still being offset for each individual until the offset is completely eliminated in 2014. Therefore, the phase out is progressive. This results in the following schedule of payments:

## Concurrent Retirement & Disability Payment (CRDP) Qualifications

- Have 20 years of military service or retired under Temporary Early Retirement Act (TERA)
- Receiving military retired pay.
- Have a 50 % or more combined rating from the VA.
- Waived retired pay to receive VA disability.
- No application is required.
- An audit is required to be done by DFAS & VA for retroactive pay.

# Combat Related Special Compensation (CRSC)

- Effective June 1, 2003, military retirees became eligible for a special monthly payment equivalent to the offset to military retired pay due to receipt of VA disability compensation determined to be combat-related.
- Qualifications have changed since the start of the program.
- An application is required.
- Decision is made by retired service.

# Combat Related Special Compensation (CRSC) History

- Effective June 1, 2003: Initial benefits were payable only to members with at least 20 years of active duty or equivalent reserve duty (i.e. 7200 points) who had combat-related disabilities totaling a rating of 60% or more, or with a rating of 10% or more for combat-related injuries for which they were awarded a Purple Heart.
- Effective January 1, 2004: Eligibility was extended to members with any level of VA rating for combat-related disabilities or Purple Heart which results in an offset to military retired pay. Additionally, eligibility was extended to members receiving Reserve retired pay (i.e., Reserve members at age 60 or younger in certain cases and with 20 "good" years or Reserve members retired under Temporary Early Retirement Authority (TERA).
- Effective January 1, 2008: Eligibility was extended to military disability retirees (i.e., Chapter 61 of title 10 United States Code) and members retired under active duty TERA rules.
- Effective January 1, 2013: The method for computing the monetary entitlement for members with military disability retirements under Chapter 61 of title 10 United States Code was changed to ensure no such members were disadvantaged from receiving an increased disability rating.
